Survey Crew / Field Survey Technician

Description:

SGC Engineering is a surveying and engineering firm based out of southern Maine providing services to the energy industry. We are seeking to add a regional field survey crew to our staff to support our work on linear energy projects. Some travel, generally limited from one to four-week assignments, will be required throughout New England and the Northeast. Approximately 40-60 percent of assignments will require travel away from the office.

Typical Duties and Responsibilities:

The survey field crew will be responsible for conducting various field assignments including construction staking, topographic surveys, existing conditions surveys, utility location, and boundary surveys. Experience operating RTK GPS and conventional total station equipment is preferred. Office tasks may also be assigned that require interaction with office personnel or drafting of data collected in the field. Applicants with a multi-faceted background and willingness to accept both field and office assignments are preferred. Knowledge and understanding of data management, AutoCAD, use of TGO or Trimble Business Center is also preferred.

Responsibility for Direction of Others:

May supervise or coordinate the work of the field crew or Cad Technician, and others who assist in specific assignments.

Additional duties may include any task as directed by a supervisor.

Education / Training:

Preference will be given to those applicants who hold an Associate's degree in engineering or surveying from an ABET accredited curriculum or five years of related experience.

Experience:

Experience working on energy infrastructure projects is preferred.
