Survey Technician I (Rod Person)

General Characteristics:

This is a survey crew position. The rod person is responsible for supporting the operational needs of the Instrument Person and the Party Chief. Learning all aspects of the Instrument Persons job should be a priority. The rod person is responsible for the efficient and effective collection of survey data to be utilized in the preparation of plans and reports. This position requires the application of standard field techniques in carrying out a sequence of related measurement tasks. Exercise of judgment is required on details of work and in making preliminary selections and adaptations of alternatives.

Direction Required:

Survey Technician I gets direction from Survey Technician III or Survey Technician II.

Typical Duties and Responsibilities:

Using prescribed methods, executes specific, field related assignments as requested by a Survey Technician II or III, Project Surveyor or Project Manager. Applies standard practices and techniques in specific situations, ensures that data is being properly collected or laid out while applying a standard of care in a time efficient manner, and follows operations through a series of related detailed steps or processes. Responsible for the organization and cleanliness of survey equipment, the equipment room and all survey vehicles. Also, responsible for notifying the project supervisor of the status of supplies that may be running low.

Client Contact:

Client contact should be deferred to the field supervisor.

Responsibility for Direction of Others:

May be assisted by a few aides, Survey Technician I additional duties may include any tasks as directed by a supervisor.

May supervise or coordinate the work of a Survey Technician I with less experience.

Education / Training:

Associates degree in engineering or surveying from an ABET accredited curriculum is preferred, though no experience is required.

Productivity:

Productivity target is 100%
